Show Info

1. Only Online Entries via HorseShowOffice are accepted.
2. Participants must pay for all classes in full when registering.
3. Attire: No shorts or soft shoes. Boots with one-inch heels should be worn.
4. Helmets: All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved equestrian safety helmet while mounted.
5. Classes may be combined/cancelled (manager's decision). Be sure to indicate which test you are riding in the Test of Choice (TOC) classes. **If no test is indicated, you will be entered in Test 3.**
6. All Tests are the current USEF, USDF and USEA tests. Shows conducted according to USDF and USEF rules.
7. All horses must be up to date on **Equine Influenza (Flu)** and **Equine Herpesvirus (EHV-1/4)** administered within 6 months of the show date. Proof of vaccination or exemption by veterinarian is required. Timing: **No vaccination within 7 days of arrival at the venue.** If you do not have proof of vaccination or your vaccines were administered within 7 days of the show your entry fees will be forfeited and you are not allowed to attend the show or enter the property.
8. Horse: Your horse may only have three (3) rides per day in this competition. Do not enter your horse in more than three classes for this one-day show. If your horse is shared with another rider, there can only be a total of three rides. The only exceptions are lead-line classes or intro tests with junior riders.
9. Any horse may be ridden by a Youth Rider (under 18) or an AA at Intro or Training regardless of what other test/level has been ridden by another rider.
10. Schedule:
 - Riders with multiple horses entered in different classes will be scheduled with the goal (not guaranteed) to allow 45 minutes between rides. Please provide your own support to accommodate that timeframe.
 - Riders riding multiple horses in the same class may not be feasible if the class is less than 45 minutes long.
11. Awards: Ribbons 1st through 4th place. Ties to be broken by higher overall collective scores on test.
12. Scored Tests will be available after the class is complete. Result summary is available online via HorseShowOffice.
13. Unclaimed tests/ribbons will be held for two days after the show. If you cannot stay for results after your ride, designate someone to pick them up. Unclaimed materials will not be mailed.
14. Preliminary Ride Times will be posted on HorseShowOffice online and emailed by Wednesday evening the week of the show. Final ride times will be posted on HorseShowOffice and Show Office by Friday at noon.
15. Haul-in or Stabling:
 - Haul-in Fee: \$25 (*Horse must be attended to when at trailer*)
 - Day stall: \$40 (matted stall no bedding, bedding available for \$15 per bale, haul-in fee included)
 - Overnight stall: \$75 (2 bags of shavings and haul-in fee included)
 - Limited number of stalls available. First come, first serve.

NOTE: Stall is required for stallions.
16. Non-competing entry: \$35 per entry. Must complete show entry and pay haul-in or stall fee.
17. Post/Late Entry: Post (or Late) entry is \$10.00 per test and is additional to class entry fee.
18. Changes: Any entry changes after closing date for classes/tests, or Horse/Rider change is \$10.00 per change.
19. **Incomplete Entries will have an additional \$10.00 office fee.**
20. Intro and Training level test may be ridden in short court (20mx40m), all other tests will be ridden in outdoor competition arena, full size (20m X 60m).

Show Rules

1. Parking: Parking attendant will direct parking.
2. Facility Use: Horses can only be tied to trailers or inside their stall.
3. No horses other than resident horses are allowed in cross-ties in front of main barn.
4. Lunging allowed in designated areas only.
5. No modifications or nailing/screwing on or in stalls allowed. Any damage to stalls will incur a minimum \$150 damage fee.
6. No Drones for any reason.
7. Dogs: Quiet, well behaved leashed dogs allowed at management discretion.
8. Decisions: All judges' decisions are final. If a judge or management decides that an animal is not fit to show, the decision will be final.
9. Disputes: Any disputes or problems during the show should be brought to the attention of the show manager.
10. Disqualification:
Grounds for disqualification and expulsion without a refund:
 - unsportsmanlike conduct
 - use of severe bits or training devices
 - unruly or out-of-control horses
 - mistreatment of any horse or student as determined by management or judges
 - exhibiting a horse that is exhausted, injured, or lame
11. NSF Checks or declined Credit Card: Returned checks (NSF, stop payment) or declined credit card will have a fee of \$50.00.
12. Refunds: Prior to closing date, full refund except office fee. No refund after closing date. The only exception is if the weather forces cancellation or shut down of show. In the event of a show cancellation all fees will be refunded.
13. Concessions are not available on the show grounds. Drinks (hot and cold) and small snacks are available to purchase.
14. We will follow USEF Dressage Rules as much as reasonable – in particular rules which are for safety or to maintain a level playing field will be followed
15. Please strip your stall or pay a fee of \$25 dollars for stall stripping. This fee will go directly to our staff members who are doing the clean-up. A sign-up sheet will be available at the show office.
